Tuesday: Avon, Halbury, Hamley Bridge, Hoyleton, Owen, Pinery

Waste Collection, 140L MGB, red lid, collected weekly.

Recycling Collection, 240L MGB, yellow lid, collected fortnightly.

Green Organics Collection 240L MGB, green lid, collected 4 weekly.

No collection on Christmas day or New Year's day, alternative day will be the following Friday.

Residents outside the townships must take their waste to a transfer station or ring Clare Valley Waste Service on the number listed above to privately arrange a MGB Collection.

#### **Transfer Stations**

Everard, Owen, Port Wakefield Ensure your load is properly covered before you leave your property so refuse is not discarded on the trip.

Loads larger than a tandem trailer MUST be taken to Cleanaway Landfill site at Inkerman, ph. 8867 1355. All transfer stations are closed on Christmas Day, New Year's Day & Good Friday.

#### Segregations at transfer stations;

- scrap metal
- electrical appliances
- TV's and computer equipment
- paper/cardboard
- Cooking oil (liquid type only)
- timber
- green waste
- car/truck batteries
- waste oil
- glass (bottles and jars only)
- carpets/mattresses
- empty fire extinguishers
- empty gas cylinders
- clean drums (not chemical containers, see below)
- dry cell batteries
- smoke detectors
- mobile phones
- hard refuse
- household waste.

#### Waste not accepted

- Ammunition/Explosives/Flares
- Asbestos
- BCF Fire Extinguishers (yellow type)
- Chemicals
- Frytol-deep fry oil (white/solid type)
- Hazardous Waste
- Liquid Waste
- Noxious Weeds
- Soil-contaminated
- Deceased animals

# Rules and regulations

- 1. All loads need to be segregated before entering the Transfer Station/Waste Depot.
- 2. Waste to be unloaded as directed by attendants (see segregation list above).
- 3. Proof of residency within Wakefield Regional Council via current Drivers licence.
- 4. Dead animals not accepted.
- 5. Must arrive early enough to be unloaded and out of depot by closing time.
- 6. Scavenging is not allowed, items can be purchased, ask attendant.
- 7. If dogs accompany depositor to waste depot they must be restrained.
- 8. Electronic Equipment—Owner is responsible for removing any confidential/private data before disposal. Once disposed of, no items are to be returned or reused.
