## APPLICATION TO KEEP MORE THAN THE PRESCRIBED NUMBER OF DOGS (OVER 3 MONTHS OF AGE)

Application to keep more than one dog in a small dwelling, commonly known as an apartment, flat, service flat, granny flat, home unit or the like.

Application to keep more than 2 dogs in premises other than a small dwelling

Application to keep more than 3 dogs in premises outside of a township, other than working dogs.

The purpose of this permit is to ensure adequate sanitation is provided and a nuisance of any kind does not occur, both of which may affect neighbouring properties.

**Conditions of Consent:**

- a) All dogs must be registered.
- b) Dog faeces must be wrapped and disposed of to prevent the emission of any offensive odours. Faeces must be disposed of regularly and may be placed into a refuse bin.
- c) Dog food and other food must be placed in clean food bowls for feeding.
- d) Dogs must not be permitted to wander at large under any circumstances.
- e) Kennels or hard surfaces must have easily cleanable and hose able flooring and cleaned regularly to eliminate any odours. Kennels should ideally be connected to sewer (if applicable).
- (f) Dogs shall not be permitted to bark so as to cause a nuisance to any other persons.

**Assessment of Application:**

Assessment of the application will have respect to any previous history of the dogs and/or the premises.

A survey letter may be sent to your neighbours to assist with your application.

Keeping dogs as a business may require development approval.

**Auditing:**

The permit may be withdrawn or reviewed by Council at any time should any conditions not be complied with or if problems arise.

Council officers reserve the right to inspect the premises at any reasonable time.

**Appeal:**

Council may by notice in writing or otherwise, require the permit holder to take specific action within a certain time period as specified.

Failure to comply with a notice may cause the permit to be withdrawn.

A person may appeal against a decision of Council. An appeal must be in writing to Council and instituted within 14 days of Council's decision.

**Being the person responsible for these dogs, I hereby agree to the above conditions should permission be granted.**
